## GOVERNMENT PUBLISHES PROGRESS REPORT

On 4 February 2012, the Government published a progress report on the Equitable Life Payment Scheme.

### Targets

In October 2010, the Government announced total compensation of £1.5 bn.

The targets set by Government are:

- To write to all eligible policyholders by mid 2012 confirming whether a payment will be made, the amount and when it will be received.
- Start to make payments to with-profits annuitants by June 2012.
- All policyholders to have received their compensation by mid 2014.

### Progress report

Payments made as at the end of January 2012 are:

- Policyholders, excluding with-profits annuitants: 84,577 policyholders have received a lump sum payment totalling over £61m
- With-profits annuitants: 11,024 policyholders have received their first payment totalling over £9m.

The progress report sets down the expectation that the vast majority of individual policyholders due a payment will have received this by mid 2012.

The next progress report is planned for summer 2012, when further numbers will be published.
